



Environmental Citizenship Activities

Danfoss actively participates in these international programs to protect the environment:

“ISO14001” - Each manufacturing location is certified to the ISO14001 Environmental Management System standard. (A voluntary program.)

“United Nations Global Compact” - A wide ranging list of corporate citizenship pledges including 3 environmental related points. (A voluntary program.)

“Charter for Sustainable Development” - An International Chamber of Commerce initiative with 16 environmental and resource management related points. (A voluntary program.)

“WEEE” – “Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment” - EU Directive seeks to increase recovery and recycling of waste electrical equipment. Became European law February 2003.

“RoHS” – “Restriction of Hazardous Substances” - EU Directive seeks to reduce the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, chromium(VI), PBB's and PBDE's in electronics by January 2006. Became European law February 2003.

“EUP” – The “Eco-design requirements for Energy-Using Products” is an EU proposal that promotes environmentally friendly “cradle-to-grave” designs of energy-using products. Official EU proposal August 2003.
